Polling was conducted by telephone June 29-30, 2010, in the evenings. The total sample is 900 registered voters nationwide with a margin of sampling error of ± 3 percentage points. Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted. Democrats n=340, ± 5 ; Republicans n=324, ± 5.5 ; Independents n=176, ± 7
