1 November 04

Polling was conducted by telephone October 30-31, 2004 during the day and in the evenings. The total registered voter sample is 805 in Florida, 792 in Iowa, 814 in Ohio, and 802 in Wisconsin. There is subsample of 700 likely voters in each state, with a margin of error of +/- 3.7 percentage points. The registered voter sample has a margin of error of +/- 3.5 percentage points.
