3 to a reasonable extent, all pertinent equipment, records, files, reports, official order forms, and
4 documents required to be made, kept and maintained under the provisions of the Controlled
5 Substances Act, 21 U.S.C. 801 et seq., for the purpose of verifying that said records, files,
6 official order forms, reports, documents and controlled substances are properly kept and
7 maintained.

9 You are hereby further authorized to remove from the above described premises all
10 records, reports, documents, files, inventories and written information which are required to be
11 made, kept and maintained under the provision of the Controlled Substances Act, 21 U.S.C. 801
12 et seq., for the purpose of copying or verifying their correctness or that they are used or intended
13 to be used in violation of the Controlled Substances Act. Any original documents so removed
14 shall be copied and returned within ten days of removal.

16 A prompt return shall be made by the inspecting officers to the duty
17 United States Magistrate Judge, showing that the inspection has been completed and accounting
18 for all property removed pursuant to this warrant, not later than ten days from the issuance of this
19 warrant.
