(403/ACM) Nordin Blacker present w th Petnr. David Blacker appearing telephonically for Petnr. Christopher Emley and Pamela Pierson appearing telephonically with and for Resp. Court read on the record the Tentative Statement of Decision. Written Statement of Decision shall follow. Parties may file their response and/or objection within 10 days upon issuance of the order. Based on the testimonies, records and evidence before the Court, Court does not find that move away is in child's best interest. Court finds that Petnr can provide a more structured continuity, stable, secure, and consistent home that child, Roan needs. Petnr shall have permanent sole physical custody of child. Court finds that Resp failed to meet her burden of proof and denies Resp's request for modification of cusitody. Parties shall agree on the tests to be done, treatment and schools re: Roan. Custody, visitation, holiday and vacation schedule shall remain in place as outlined on 10/4/07 order. Parties shall not take child out of school. Tutoring programs shall be determined and decided by both parties. Both parties may seek assistance from Tony Heineman if needed. David Fink shall continue to be the settlement master as previously stipulated. Each party shall provide 2 weeks notice to other party regarding any medical appointment for child. Resp shall have access to child. Resp's number shall be programmed on child's telephone and home phone. Court notes that this order is permanent unless there's a change of circumstance which is defined as Res p relocating to SF or Petnr moving outside SF or Marin County. Court reserves issues on AF.
