16 December 2010

Polling was conducted by telephone December 14-15, 2010, in the evenings. The total sample is 900 registered voters nationwide with a margin of sampling error of ± 3 percentage points.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted. LV = likely voters Democrats n=314, ± 5.5 ; Republicans n=346, ± 5 ; Independents n=187, ± 7
